Mission

Youth lead Vacation Bible School each morning at the Zeba Indian Mission for the children of this community. Youth contribute by planning and leading the daily lessons with singing, drama, crafts, and games.

Lodging

We will stay at the Michigan Tech Conference Center at the Henry Ford Alberta Village through Friday morning, July 20. On the last night, we sleep at a church in St. Ignace or Mackinac City.

Sightseeing

Includes Keeweenaw Peninsula, Adventure Mine, an afternoon on Mackinac Island, Copper Harbor, swimming, and waterfalls.

Sol Café Class Requirements

To prepare the team, four preparatory sessions will be offered during Sol Café at 9:30 beginning on April 15 and running through May 13. Team members, both youth and counselors, are expected to attend these classes.

Cost

Estimated cost is \$525 per person. All lodging, meals, and snacks will be provided. Through our fundraising resources, we hope to grant each participant about \$150 toward the cost.

We expect families to participate in youth fundraisers (such as using GL Scrip) to help us meet this goal.

We need a deposit of \$125 by March 30 to guarantee your space on this trip. Additional scholarships are available upon request. Scholarship requests are due by March 30, 2012.
