

Volunteer Opportunities in Youth Ministry

There are many ways for an adult to get involved in youth ministry:

- **Counselor:** Our counselors are the adult volunteers who help run the Sunday evening fellowship program for our youth. They might take a leadership role during an evening program, participate in a small group discussion or perhaps help run a game.
- **Teacher:** Our teachers facilitate our Sunday morning faith exploration program known as the Sol Café. They are the lead teachers for the classes on Sunday mornings and usually sign up for a semester at a time.
- **Trip Leaders:** Our trip leaders accompany the youth on one of our many overnight excursions. The leaders are responsible for general oversight of the youth on the trip and are also assigned specific tasks or duties depending on the nature of the trip.
- **Parent Council:** Our parent council works behind the scenes for specific events that we have during the year. If you are a person with strong organizational skills, this group is for you.
