

Support FUMC Youth Service Trips When You Buy Gift Cards From the Youth Scrip Gift Card Program

FUMC Youth have participated in summer service trips and projects for many years. The cost to go on a service trip is the responsibility of the youth's family. Fundraising through the Youth Gift Card Program lowers the cost to each participant. Scholarships are available to anyone wanting to go on a mission. The Youth Group receives a percentage of each gift card sold.

There are two ways to buy gift cards online. From your computer, go to www.raiseright.com and on a smart phone use the Raise Right app (if you purchased gift cards from shopwithscrip.com your credentials will work on RaiseRight.com).

1. To get started you'll need an enrollment code. Send a request to jenn@fumc-a2.org. You will receive an email invitation with the code to join the FUMC Youth scrip gift card program at raiseright.com. Use this link to create a username and password. Now you are ready to order gift cards from your computer.
2. To order gift cards from your smart phone, install the RaiseRight application from the site you prefer for smartphone apps. The username and password are the same as you created in step 1. The RaiseRight app wallet keeps track of your gift card balance and can be used as a contactless form of payment.

After completing these steps, you can order gift cards; reload gift cards purchased from the FUMC Youth scrip gift card program; or buy electronic gift cards. Some brands have a "ship to home option". Electronic gift cards are stored in your RaiseRight wallet or sent to the gift recipient's email.

Payment can be made in one of these ways:

- Check made payable to FUMC Youth.
- Church Center app, select Youth Gift Card Program (scrip).
- Debit card (1.0% convenience fee) on Raiseright.com.
- Credit card (3.0% convenience fee) on Raiseright.com.
- Automatic debit to a linked bank account (see instructions to link bank account at raiseright.com). This method provides the fastest turnaround for reloadable cards.
