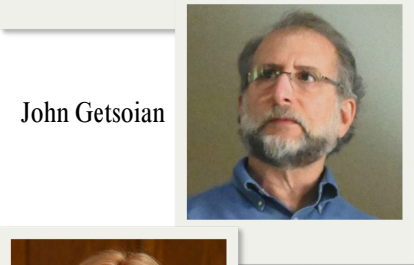
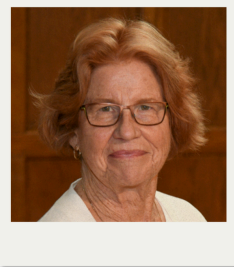

FINANCE COMMITTEE

The Finance Committee meets on the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

In keeping with the Welcoming Statement, the Finance committee strives to strike a diverse balance on the committee in terms of demographics, occupational backgrounds, and life experience, so as to achieve a well-rounded approach in matters pertaining to FUMC. It is helpful to Finance to have one member with advanced or professional experience in finance. However, genuine love and concern for FUMC and its ministries is the most important qualification.

Committee Responsibilities:

- Compile an annual budget for the church and submit it to Leadership Council
- Develop and implement plans to raise income to meet the budget
- Administer funds as directed by Leadership Council
- Provide regular review and oversight of financial activity for the church.
- Recommend where to deposit funds and ensure they are deposited promptly
- Report the status of designated funds regularly to Leadership Council
